Player Code of Conduct

Purpose: Bloomington United strives to provide a positive, respectful, and competitive environment for all players, coaches, family members and spectators of both our club as well as our competitors. Players are expected to abide by club expectations that align with these objectives.

Player Expectations:

1. Players should respect teammates, opponents, game officials, coaches and spectators at all times by refraining from harassment, bullying, hazing, and use of profanities.
2. Players must never under any circumstance participate in physical violence.
3. Players are prohibited from using substances including alcohol, tobacco, cannabis, or illegal drugs while on an active roster.
4. Players will attend most practices and games during the season and will notify coaches in advance of absences.
5. Players are expected to arrive on time to practices and games.
6. Players are expected to have proper equipment with them at all games and practices including proper shoes, shinguards, a soccer ball, water, and uniform.
7. Players should refrain from using cell phones or other personal electronic devices during practices and games.
8. Players should pay attention to their coach and refrain from distracting others from useful instruction during practices and games

Violations: Players who do not comply with the Player Code of Conduct may be subject to the following repercussions based on the severity and frequency of violations:

- Notification to parent / guardian of an issue
- Reduced play time
- Suspension from practices and/or games
- Removal from roster and no placement on future Bloomington United teams
